**Living in the 1800's (June 13-16):** Students will learn what it was like to live in the late 1800's. Children will learn various responsibilities for boys and girls. They will learn calligraphy, hand sewing, how to make soap, and various other experiments.

**Space Week Astronaut Training (June 27-30th):** Students will get to experience what it is like to be an astronaut and delve into education, endurance, food in space and experimental skills. The children will get to experience throughout the workshop what experiments have been done on the Space Station. There

will be various new experiments that were not done in last year's class. On June 30<sup>th</sup> is National Asteroid Day. We will be participating in a world sharing event.

**Cemetery and Genealogy Studies (July 11-14)** The children will learn how far back does their genealogy goes, how to make a family tree, the importance of cemeteries, how to use the Elizabeth Historical Society and how to use ancestry.com.

**Oceanography, Fresh Water and Climate Change (July 25<sup>th</sup> - 29):** Students will be introduced to the underwater world of fish, currents and plants. They will be examining fish and learn why we must pro-

tect our oceans and streams. This year they will be introduced to weather and climate change.

**Planet Earth & It's Neighbors (August 8-11):** The young scientists will be introduced to rocks and minerals. Various hands-on experiments will be preformed. Students will also learn about the layers of Earth, Earth's plates and volcanoes. Students will also learn about the solar system with hands-on activities.
